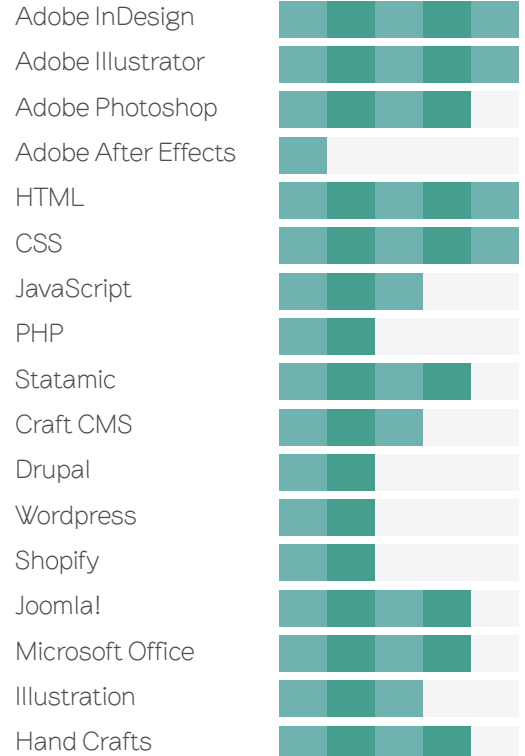
## Education
